This is a resounding NO. Please put on your thinking caps on one more time. An unprotected 1.5 million metric tonne coal mountain permanently parked open to the elements is unacceptable. Transportation issues from minehead to tidewater have not been addressed at all.

My solution is to control logistics of transport by dispatching coal on demand, have a terminal stream lined strictly from train to boat without the convenience of long-term open air storage. Control the storage of coal at the mine head.
